<sup>2</sup> Beyond ceilings referring to Section 9, Paragraph 2 *Law on the Creation of a Foundation “Remembrance, Responsibility and Future”*, the Foundation used all accrued interest (apart from “Remembrance and Future” Fund) achieved until the conclusion of the payment programs, including external donations, to support the ceilings to compensation for forced labor and other personal injury. After the conclusion of the payment programs, all residual funds were used for humanitarian programs of the partner organizations. Due to the accrued interest the total amount of ceilings increased compared to the ceilings defined during the international negotiations and by the *Law on the Creation of a Foundation “Remembrance, Responsibility and Future.”*
